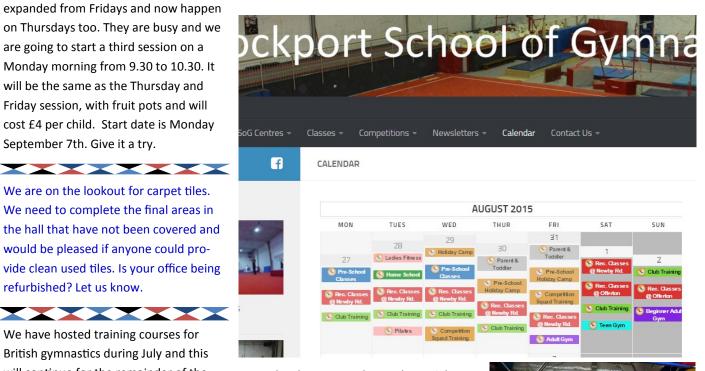
SSoG Calendar of Daily events
