


Stockport School of Gymnastics

Centre Improvements

During July we have been busy with painting the public areas of the gym, upgrading the CCTV and security systems, fitting new notice boards and signage. The main activity has been out of sight under the U Pit where par-

ents have been adding floors, walls and shelves to make a new store for Pre-School equipment.

The existing Pre-School store room is to be developed for staff and coaches.

In the next few weeks the

painting will be completed and additional lockers fitted so that all gymnasts have room to stow their belongings during their classes.



Our annual fee for Club Membership (excluding the Competitive Club) will be £10 for 2017/18. This increase is to help us to improve the club, through training and development of our coaches, improve our facility and introduce new equipment to our gym, the increase is approximately 10p per week per member and will be invoiced for in October along with the BG insurance.
