




BG Core Proficiency Scheme

We have been catching up with testing for the British Gymnastics Core Proficiency Scheme and to help you understand a little better on how the scheme works we have produced a booklet, called My Gymnastics, which is a record of how the gymnast has progressed and what the skills are to practice for the next badge. The booklets are available in the gym and can be signed off by your coach when testing has happened. There are spaces for you to list your competitions and put your stickers. On the back page are some important contacts.

We have also put a page on the website with all the Skill Sets listed and some picture of what we expect. It's on the main website menu as Skill Sets so have a look and get up to speed.

The Club Champion is Becky Mooney, pictured on the front page of the newsletter. She will keep the Frank Williams Trophy for the next 12 months.



























Christmas Holiday Camps

The ever popular holiday camps are online and will be filling fast during December.

Thursday 2nd January

This is a tumble and bounce camp - children need to be competent with cartwheels, bridges and working towards round offs as a minimum requirement. It is for aged 7 years and upwards at Newby Road. Price £30.

Friday 3rd January

9.30 to 12.00

This is an Open play Parent and Toddler session for children 0-6 years at Newby Rd. Price £5.00.

Friday 3rd January

1.00 to 4.00.

This is a half day holiday camp - all pieces will be used in the session. It is for 5 years upwards at Newby Road. Price £15.

Competition Numbers

Next to the children's names (please check the spelling of your child's name as this will be on the certificate) is a number, this is their competition number. This year we are asking all the gymnast to make their own number on a min of A4 paper and design it as they wish. The best designed number for each round will win a prize on the day.

Routines

Our coaches will be working on the routines with the children during their recreational sessions. The routines are performed in one or two lines along the floor and not to music. Children may wish to practice at home. The moves have been sent to all gymnasts, but if you have not yet had yours, please ask the office.

On the day

The tuck shop will be open for refreshments, DE Photography will be in the gym to take pictures which you can purchase should you wish to do so; they make great Christmas Presents.

We will be having displays from our competition squad and club gymnasts it will be a great day, please bring your friend and family to the gym to watch our amazing gymnasts.

How long does it take?

On the rotations there is a warm up time, for instance Round 5 is at 12.45. Turn up 15 minutes before this time. There will be coaches around to check you in. After the general warm up you will be lined up and marched onto the competition floor and presented to the parents. You will then get a warm up on your start piece, which is indicated on the rotations. You will compete on that piece. You then move to your second piece and will warm up again and then compete. After the competition there will be a display by the club gymnasts while the scores are being added up. Then there is the presentation of medals and after that you are free to go. The whole competition is 1 hr 15 minutes maximum.
