
Ordering Club Kit

Trip to Lilleshall

After a break of a couple of years we are pleased to announce that we will be running a training camp at Lilleshall in the summer. Most coaches are good to go and we have reserved places for 24 gymnasts.

Dave will do a presentation in the cafe upstairs on Saturday 3rd Feb at 1.15 for all club coaches, parents & gymnasts so you can see what we got up to in previous visits and for all to ask questions about this visit

The dates are confirmed as Sunday 5th to Tuesday 7th August 2018. The cost includes two nights accommodation, all meals including lunch on arrival & before we depart, return coach transport & exclusive gym training facility hire. It will also cover event merchandise. We will need a deposit once the numbers have been worked ot for the final costs.

The club will offer an amount towards the cost to subsidise the event & the plan is for parents to fundraise to reduce the cost to individuals & make the event more accessible to all eligible gymnasts.

Lilleshall is the home of British Gymnastics and the best training facility in the UK. The Kings Hall and Princess Royal Hall are connected with the first hall having have two artistic floors and tumble track and multiple beams and bars. There are two seated viewing areas suitable for parents or spectators. The second hall has a large pitted area perfect as a safe practice area for some of the higher equipment and includes vault, beam and bars entry to the pits and a fast track.

The hall has extensive grounds and in previous years we have spent the evenings playing games and exploring.

The accommodation is in double rooms and all meals are taken in the main hall. No guarantees, but every trip so far we have met gymnasts from the National Squad.
