New Class—Gym Babies

We have found that the Governments tokens for Nursery places has impacted on the number of children attending the Pre-School Classes. Other gym clubs have stopped the sessions completely, but we are continuing our classes and will be offering weekend classes in 2020.

In the meantime we will be starting a class called Gym Babies for those children not yet in Nursery. These classes will be a semi-structured one hour session for children aged 1 to 2.5 years exploring fun themes in a safe environment with their parents.

The cost will be £5 for the hour, term time only. Classes can be booked online and start on Tuesday 29th October, 11am – 12 noon. They are already on the website for booking.

We hope that the classes hit the mark and if popular we will expand to other days of the week.

A huge thanks to the ever present Suzanne Winterbone for organising the bag packing this weekend at Morrison's in Bredbury. Not only that, the counting and bagging up after a long weekend on her feet. We covered most opening hours with up to 11 gymnasts covering each of the 1.5 to 2 hour turns. In all 43 gymnasts from Club and Comp Squad attended, not 100% but better than usual. The more you can get the better the income and if you missed this one we have another one on 7th and 8th December.

This weekend we raised £1,315 making a big dent in the target of £9,000 to purchase a new floor covering. The thermometer says £2,500, but this will take it to £4,000, nearly half way there.

Club and Competition Squad Performance Pathway

Tamlynn and Tracey are currently working hard to develop a clear development pathway for all Club and Comp Squad gymnasts so that they progress their gymnastic skills and are able to co compete at higher levels going forward. This is not an easy process – as gymnasts do progress they will be moved to work with different coaches, into different groups and may need to train different hours on different days. You may already have begun to experience this. If a gymnast is not progressing they may also be moved and have their hours reduced. This is being done for all gymnasts benefit and to ensure the best possible outcomes for your child.

If you are wondering how the Club
Training is structured we have: a basics
night once a week, to perfect the basic
compulsory requirements; one night of
skills work where they have an opportunity to upgrade their skills and twice
a week they are perfecting routines as
we have a number of competitions
coming up. Once competitions are
over, there will be more time spent on
upgrading skills and less on perfecting
routines. Conditioning is done most
sessions as this is vital to their development and to avoid injury.

Gymnasts are entered for competitions on the understanding that they have achieved and can compete the compulsory requirements for the individual competitions. We may, however, withdraw gymnasts if they subsequently do not meet them in performing their routines in training. Our aim is to ensure that Stockport School of Gymnastics supports the development of high performance in our gymnasts recognising that they all develop differently.
