Gymnastics in September

All Rec, Pre-School and Teen sessions run from 1st to the 30th of September and Ladies Fitness will return the week commencing September 5th.

Pre-School

In September our Pre-School sessions will return to how they were pre-covid. Sessions on a Monday, Thursday and Friday at 10:15 will be with parent sessions and sessions at 11:15 will be independent sessions and all Pre-School sessions on a Wednesday will remain a mix of with parent and independent gymnasts. This is another British Gymnastics RISE theme, which means its certificate time at the end of this one.

Recreational
